

GETTING STARTED BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned **OFF**.
- 2. Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw.
- Install 2 new 'AAA' (LR03/AM-4) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)



4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH), or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- · Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.

- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

With the VTech® Musical Mouse Teether™ safety comes first. To ensure your child's safety, this product should only be assembled by an adult.

 To detach the teether for washing, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and remove the battery cover. Remove the soft plastic cheese teether.



- Before using the teether for the first time and after each use, wash with warm soapy water, rinse and air dry. DO NOT use boiling water, steam, a microwave or dishwasher to clean the teether. Check the teether regularily for wear. Discard the teether if any cracks or tears are found on the teether.
- Re-attach the soft plastic cheese teether to the main unit. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



PRODUCT FEATURES

1. ON/OFF SWITCH

To turn the unit **ON**, slide the **ON/OFF SWITCH** to the **ON** (**७**) position. To turn the unit **OFF**, slide the **ON/OFF SWITCH** to the **OFF** (**●**) position.



2. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, the VTech® Musical Mouse Teether™ will automatically power-down after approximately 30 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button. Activating the motion sensor will not turn the unit back on.

ACTIVITIES

 Slide the on/off switch to turn the unit on. You will hear a song and a fun phrase. The light will flash with the sound.



Press the light-up heart button to hear a song, melodies, sounds and phrases. The light will flash with the sound.



 Activate the motion sensor to hear a variety of melodies, sounds or a song. When a melody is playing, shake the rattle to play sounds over the top of the melody. The light will flash with the sound.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit **OFF**.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **ON**. The unit should now be ready to play again.
