

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GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- 2. Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the unit and open it.
- Install 4 new "AA" batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new, alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)



4. Close the battery cover.


