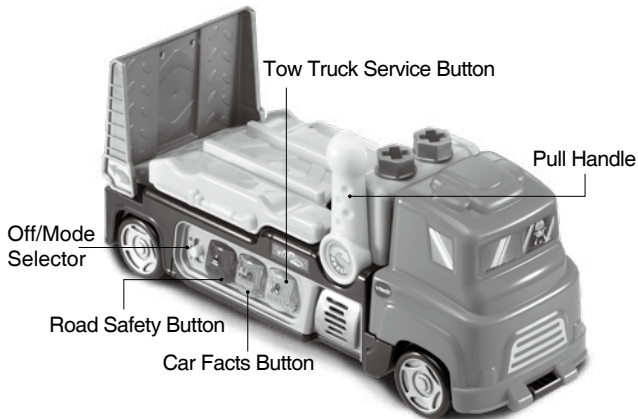

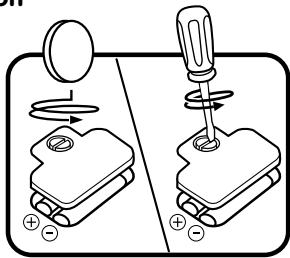

GETTING STARTED

Battery Removal and Installation

1. Make sure the unit is turned **Off**.
2. Find the battery cover located on the bottom of the unit and use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and open the battery cover.
3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
4. Install 2 new AA size (LR6/AM-3) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box.
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



BATTERY NOTICE

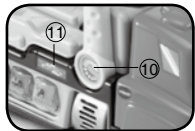
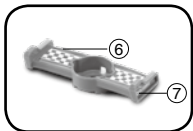
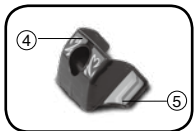
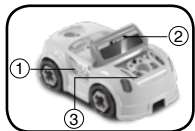
- Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable, or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

MISE EN GARDE

- Utiliser des piles alcalines neuves pour des performances maximales.

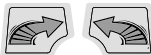

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. Off/Mode Selector

Slide the **Off/Mode Selector** to turn the unit **On** and enter Explore mode  or Challenge mode . To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **Off/Mode Selector** to the **Off**  position.



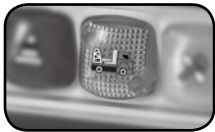
2. Road Safety Button

Press the **Road Safety Button** to learn about road safety and the color red.



3. Car Facts Button

Press the **Car Facts Button** to learn about the color yellow and interesting facts about the car and the tow truck.



4. Tow Truck Service Button

Press the **Tow Truck Service Button** to learn about the color green and how a tow truck services a car.



5. Pull Handle

Use the **Pull Handle** to launch the car into the race.



6. Custom Car

Place the car on the tow truck to hear funny conversations between the vehicles, and add different accessories to create and fix your unique car.



7. Pull Along the Truck

Pull along the tow truck to hear melodies and fun sing-along songs.

8. Storage

Open the truck hood to store the accessories inside.



9. Volume Control Switch

Slide the **Volume Control Switch** on the bottom of the tow truck to adjust the volume.

10. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the unit will automatically shut off after several minutes without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button, putting the car back on the tow truck or sliding the **Off/Mode Selector** from one mode to the other.

Activities

1. Explore Mode

In Explore mode, learn about tow truck services, car facts, road safety and colors. Mix and match the accessories to build your unique car. Be imaginative!



2. Challenge Mode

Follow the tow truck's directions to find the right pieces to build and customize a cool car. Play a memory game to finish the tasks by pressing the color buttons in the right order.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Turn the unit **Off**.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit back **On**. The unit should now be ready to use again.
5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
