


Unlock the packaging locks:



- ① Turn the packaging locks counterclockwise several times.
- 2 Pull out and discard the packaging lock.

GETTING STARTED BATTERY INSTALLATION Fire Truck

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the Fire Truck. Use a coin or a screwdriver to loosen the screw.
- Install 2 new AAA (AM-4/LR03) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)
- 4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure the battery cover.





BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable, or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- · Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.





ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Save the Day Fire Station™

With the VTech® Go! Go! Smart Wheels® Save the Day Fire Station™, safety comes first. To ensure your child's safety, adult assembly is required.

1. Connect the Blue Base and Gray Base together. Then, attach
the Fire Station to the bases, as shown below. You will hear a "click"
sound when the Fire Station is secure. Once the Fire Station is
attached, it cannot be removed.







Insert the Sign into the top of the Fire Station. You will hear a "click" sound to indicate it is secure.



 Attach the House Wall to the Gray Base and Fire Station, as shown below. You will hear a "click" sound to indicate it is secure. Once the House Wall is attached, it cannot be removed.




4. Attach the **Elevator Platform** to the **Fire Station**, as shown below. Lift it up and down smoothly to make sure it is secure.




 Insert the Top Ramp Track Support into the Gray Base. You will hear a "click" sound to indicate it is secure. Once the Top Ramp Track Support is attached, it cannot be removed.




Attach the Top Ramp Track to the Top Ramp Track Support and the House Wall. You will hear a "click" sound to indicate the pieces are secure.




 Attach the Bottom Ramp Track Support to the Bottom Ramp Track and connect this to the Top Ramp Track, as shown below




8. Insert the **Fire Plates** into both ramp tracks ensuring that you see the fire labels from the front of the playset, as shown below.



9. Insert the **Pole** into the **Blue Base**. You will hear a "click" sound to indicate it is secure.




10. Insert the Spinning Platform onto the Pole and spin it up and down smoothly to make sure it is secure.




11. Insert the **Parking Bracket** onto the **Pole** and **Fire Station**. You will hear a "click" sound to indicate it is secure.



12. Attach the **Parking Platform** to the **Parking Bracket**. You will hear a "click" sound to indicate it is secure.



13. Insert the Fire Piece into the House Wall. You will hear a "click" sound to indicate it is secure.



Once you've completed the above steps, you are ready to play! Attach the remaining track pieces or you can connect this playset to other **Go! Go! Smart Wheels**® playsets (each sold separately).



EXPAND & EXPLORE

Connect this playset to the Go! Go! Smart Wheels® Levels & Ramps Track Set™ (as shown below) or to other Go! Go! Smart Wheels® playsets (each sold separately) to expand play and inspire creativity.



PRODUCT FEATURES

Fire Truck

1. ON/OFF SWITCH

To turn the Fire Truck **ON**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **ON** (\circlearrowleft) position. To turn the Fire Truck **OFF**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **OFF** (\bullet) position.



2. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, the included Fire Truck will automatically power down after approximately 50 seconds without input. The unit can only be turned on again by pressing the **Light-Up Button**, pushing the Fire Truck quickly or triggering a **SmartPoint**® location.

Note: This product is in try-me mode in the packaging. After opening the package, turn the vehicle off and on again to proceed with normal play. If the unit powers down while playing, we suggest changing the batteries.

ACTIVITIES

Fire Truck

1. Light-Up Button

Press the **Light-Up Button** to hear fun sounds, songs and phrases. The light will flash with the sounds.



2. Music

Push the Fire Truck to hear fun sounds and melodies. While a melody is playing, continue pushing the Fire Truck to add in fun sounds on top of the melody. The light will flash with sounds.



3. SmartPoint® Locations

For added fun, the Fire Truck interacts with the Go! Go! Smart Wheels® Save the Day Fire Station™. Simply put the Fire Truck on one of the playset's four SmartPoint® locations to see the Fire Truck's light flash and to hear fun sounds, short tunes and



phrases. The Fire Truck even interacts with other **Go! Go! Smart Wheels**® playsets (each playset sold separately).

ACTIVITIES

Fire Station

1. SmartPoint® Locations

Place the Fire Truck or any **SmartPoint®** vehicle (each sold separately) on any of the playset's four **SmartPoint®** locations to trigger fun sounds, songs or phrases.



2. Elevator

Put the Fire Truck on the **SmartPoint®** elevator platform and lift the elevator up to the top of the fire station.



3. Ramp

Watch the Fire Truck roll down the long ramp.



4. Fire Pole

Slide the Fire Truck from the top of the fire station to see it spin down the pole.



5. Fire Station Doors

Flip open the fire station door to have role-play fun with the Fire Truck.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- Remove the batteries when the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit sit for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **ON**. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- If the product still does not work, replace with an entire set of new batteries.
